Flavors of ripe cherry, Logan berry and vanilla flood the palate. Our second vintage of Napa Valley Cabernet produced a more serious wine this year.

The 2010 vintage offers a note of sophistication with a more rich, dark, tamed nose that's seductive and captivating. The tannins integrate beautifully into the wine as it opens to show its nice earth and terroir components. It's big, rich, and chewy on the palate with a long and graceful finish.
