2013 PINOT NOIR

Beautiful garnet hue. The aroma suggests a medley of strawberry and raspberry with a slight hint of toasty oak. Medium body and lively on the palate, the crisp natural acidity lifts these aromas and provides a long elegant finish.

Aged one year in 100% new Burgundian cooperage and another year in the bottle, the 2013 Pinot Noir is drinking very well, with ample natural acidity to develop for years to come. This Pinot's expression and balance combine to create a wine of nuance, finesse and beauty.

Wine: 2013 Pinot Noir

Appellation: Carneros, Napa [Hudson vineyard]

Vineyard: Area Bob calls "Upper Carneros" where the Mayacamas Mountain range completes its run. Volcanic tuff soil with warm days and cool nights.

Variety: 100% Pinot Noir [Clones 777 (Pommard) and 5 (UC Davis)]

Harvest: Hand picked in September 2012

Vinification: Ten-day fermentation, hand punch-down, new French Oak barrels

Alcohol: 12.7%

Bottled: September 2015

Production: 600 cases
