One of the lost grape varieties – almost. There are only about 40 acres of it in production. Charbono is lighter in body and lower in alcohol than many reds, and has a unique complexity. Aromas display elements of grape jelly, Italian herbs and spices, and red rose petals. The mid-palate is quite delicate, and a lively acidity helps create a long, lingering finish. This is a very versatile food wine!
