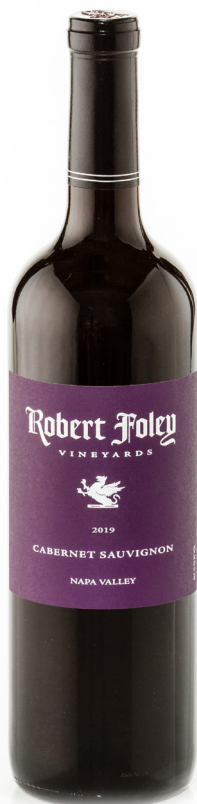

2019 NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This classic Napa Valley Cabernet displays a marriage of mountain- and valley-fruit personalities. The high elevations give structural aspects of acidity and grip and spice the grapes with the surrounding forest aromas, while the warmer valley fruit lends a soft lushness. Yin and Yang.

Aromas of black and red cherries dance with just a hint of camphor. Barrel aged for two years, only 30% new French oak was used, allowing the fruit character to remain the primary focus.

This beautifully balanced 100% Cabernet Sauvignon resolves on the palate with a long, lingering fruit-driven finish. [93 Jeb Dunnuck]
