A light blush salmon hue sparkles in our new issue of the Hawksbill Rosé, named for the sea turtles in the Caribbean. Cabernet, Merlot, and Pinot Noir grapes were lightly pressed and the fresh juice fermented to produce this light, crisp delight. The flavors of ripe fresh strawberry linger long on the palate with ample acidity to leave your mouth watering for another sip. It's always rosé season!

The Hawksbill turtle is indigenous to the waters of the Caribbean, including our favorite place, St. John, USVI, which received widespread devastation during the 2017 hurricane season. After vacationing there for the past 15 years, the island and its people have become near and dear to our hearts. Our first Hawksbill offering was a benefit for the island's recovery; this bottling is an homage to its rebirth.
